Engage

Gather input from community stakeholders including board members, staff and students. Use survey for input from those who cannot attend planning meetings.

Focus

Analyze and synthesize data gathered from stakeholders along with current district data to formulate strategic goals. Develop action plans to achieve strategic goals.

Execute

Review full strategic plan for board approval. Create board and district goals aligned to approved strategic plan.

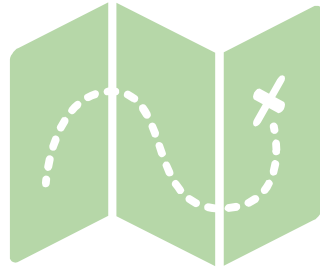
